Challenges

Murtala Muhammed Airport Terminal Two (MMA2), Nigeria's preeminent air terminal, had a video surveillance system that could no longer meet its safety and security challenges. The system was comprised of 60 Pelco analog high-speed dome cameras, four Pelco hybrid video recorders and a Pelco matrix/switcher controller. While still functional, the security system was challenged with typical analog technology issues including low resolution, low video retention and limited storage. Added to this were problems of decaying infrastructure, the high cost of maintenance and communication failures. Airport management was seeking a new comprehensive video surveillance system to better secure and protect their expansive facility.

Solution

Working with local system integrator BOW Dynamic Systems Ltd., the airport upgraded its surveillance solution to include the Pelco VideoXpert™ Video Management System, Sarix™ low-light IP cameras, high-resolution Spectra™ PTZ dome cameras, and Optera™ panoramic cameras.
